#### **Pre-College Program Application Directions:**

- Accurately complete the Student Information Form below.
- Use the form to complete the online Winthrop University's Pre-College Program Application
  - <https://apply.winthrop.edu/register/precollege>
  - **IMPORTANT:** The information on your Pre-College Program Application will be used to issue official Winthrop University transcripts and register you with the National Student Clearinghouse. Please ensure that all information is completed and accurate.
- Once you submit your online application, you will receive a confirmation email. Forward the confirmation email to your High School AP Teacher.
- Deadline to apply is **Friday, May 19<sup>th</sup> by 5:00pm.**
  - Late applications will not be accepted

#### **Dual Credit Eligibility:**

- If you scored a composite score of **5 or higher** on the March STAMP assessment with no domain less than a 4, complete the online Pre-College Program Application and you will be registered for SPAN or FREN 250.
- If you scored **less than a 5** on the STAMP assessment, complete the online Pre-College Program application and you can become eligible for the program by:
  - Retake the STAMP assessment May 15<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> to earn a composite score of 5 or higher.
  - Take the AP Exam on May 10<sup>th</sup> or May 11<sup>th</sup>. Must earn a 4 or higher on AP exam.
    - If you do not earn a 5 or higher on the May STAMP retest **or** a 4 or high on the AP Exam, RHHS Counseling Department will contact you to adjust your high school schedule and your Pre-College Application will be automatically withdrawn for 2023-24.

  - verification of citizenship (**choose one** of the following documents to upload):  
Copy of: Driver’s License, Certified Birth Certificate, Certification of Naturalization (USCIS Form N-550), US gov issued Consular Report of Birth Abroad, or Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561).

  - Full-face view directly facing the camera
  - Solid-colored; light, plain backdrop
  - Individual photo with no other people/things/animals
