

A New Day: April 14 Inauguration of Edward Serna Makes Winthrop History; First Alumnus to Assume Presidency

Winthrop will celebrate a new day in its history when President Edward A. Serna
202 is installed as the institution's 12th president during an April 14 investiture ceremony. The special celebratory event will begin at 11 a.m. in the Winthrop Coliseum. The ceremony's keynote speaker is a former colleague of Serna's from the University of Arkansas-Fort Smith. Dr. Paul Beran, who was chancellor of the Arkansas institution, will talk on Serna's rise to leadership and his academic philosophy. Following the ceremony, the activities will move to the main campus for a 12:30 p.m. picnic on the Campus Green. The community is encouraged to share a meal and then explore the campus and attend many of the scheduled


Featured Events: Upstate and Atlanta Alumni Receptions with President Serna
