Winthrop Climbs to Highest Ranking in "Best Colleges" Rankings



Winthrop moved to fifth place – its highest ranking ever – among public universities in the South, according to U.S. News & World Report's 2024 edition of "Best Colleges." Winthrop also moved up as an institution that is rated among the top five in the South for veterans; is now a top performer on social mobility; and rose to 11th place among regional public and private universities in the South.


Show Your Winthrop Spirit on Garnet and Gold Friday
