

TRUSTEES VOTE ON FACILITIES UPGRADES, SUMMER TUITION

February 2021



Earlier this month, the Board of Trustees voted to authorize a \$21 million bond issue to support housing and dining projects. Board members also voted to leave in place the discounted fee structure for Summer Session 2021.

The housing portion of the bonds will be \$9 million while up to \$12 million will go toward dining. Summer enrollment in undergraduate and graduate courses grew to 1,903 in 2020.


