Board of Trustees Approves Four New Degrees

The Board of Trustees unanimously approved the creation of new undergraduate and graduate degrees at its March 13 meeting. The three new undergraduate degrees are: Bachelor of Arts in data science, Bachelor of Science in applied software development and Bachelor of Science in educational studies. The board also voted to expand the Master of Arts in Teaching program (M.A.T.) in four areas (early childhood education, elementary education, middle-level education and special education).
