## 1. The following graduate course actions were approved:

i. Add new course: BIOL 532, Cancer Biology

Exploration of molecular pathologies underlying the hallmarks of human cancers; fulfilling the gap of not offering anything that examines the detailed molecular and cellular events mediating cancer development and progression; distinguishing Winthrop from other comparable universities in this region.

ii. Add new certificate program: CERT-DRWR, Digital Rhetoric and Writing

12-hour Post-BA certificate for students to gain professional skills in producing content for digital media; using the already-existing courses; offering additional professional credentials to existing graduate students, undergraduate but not English majors, and those who do not have time to complete the MA degree.

iii. <u>Add new certificate program: CERT-CRWR</u>, Creative Writing Specialization

12-hour Post-BA certificate for students to gain professional skills in producing original creative works suitable for professional publication; through skill-based learning and intensive workshops; using the already-existing courses; offering additional professional credentials to existing graduate students, undergraduate but not English majors, and those who do not have time to complete the MA degree.
