

Psychopathology & Psychodiagnostics Admission Requirements

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: For admission, an applicant must:

- 1. Submit an online Winthrop University Graduate School Application.
- 2. Hold a master's degree from a regionally accredited college or university in social work or a human services field.
- 3. Submit official transcripts from ALL colleges and universities attended. Transcripts must be sent directly to Winthrop's Graduate School office from issuing institution(s).

Note: Students who are admitted as non-degree are not eligible for financial aid, graduate assistantships, or scholarships.

COURSE INFORMATION:

SCWK 623: Psychopathology & Empowerment Practice (3 credit hours)

- <u>Fall Semester</u>: Traditional weekly meeting format. Class meets on campus in Rock Hill one day per week throughout the semester.
- <u>Spring Semester</u>: Intensive weekend format. Class meets on campus in Rock Hill two weekends during the semester, supplemented by periods of independent study before, in between, and after weekend meetings.
