NOTES

1. Unless stated otherwise, a single course **may not** be used for more than one General Education requirement or in a major and a minor.
2. All Arts and Sciences majors require a minimum of 40 hours in courses numbered above 299.
3. Attendance at three cultural events is required for each 20 hours completed in residence at Winthrop.
4. **May apply 6 additional SPAN hours beyond major requirements toward 120 hour requirement.**
5. Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application will be considered the same designator.

6. Complete WRIT 101, HMPX 102, and CRTW 201 with a C- or better by 75 hours.
7. Apply to graduate program in fall of last year.
8. Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
9. Completion of the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview with a rating of advanced low or higher is expected before admission.
10. EDUC 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
