- 5. Complete WRIT 101, HMXP 102, and CRTW 201 with a C- or better by 75 hours.
- 6. Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
- 7. Students must have a GPA of at least 2.75 at graduation.
- 8. EDCO 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
