- Unless stated otherwise, a single course **may not** be used for more than one General Education requirement or in a major or minor.
  - All Arts and Sciences majors require a minimum of 40 hours in courses numbered above 299.
  - Attendance at three cultural events is required for each 20 hours completed in residence at Winthrop.
  - No more than 39 hours in ENGL may be applied to the 120-hour requirement.
  - Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application are considered the same designator.
  - Students should complete WRIT 101, HMXP 102 and CRTW 201 with a C- or better early in their academic careers.
  - Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
  - EDCO 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
