This plan totals 120 credits. Students may request 8 credits for SPAN 101 and 102, after receiving a grade of B or higher in SPAN 201 or another Spanish course at the 200, 300 or 400 level. These credits may be used to reduce the number of lower-division electives needed for graduation.

* CRTW 201 should be taken sometime during the Sophomore year. This could be either fall or spring, depending upon course availability, major program requirements, and/or study abroad placement options.
**When selecting electives, students need to be sure that they have taken 40 credits above 299. These electives could be in Spanish or other courses at the 300-level or higher.
