


CAMPUS FRANCE USA

is a service provided by the French Embassy in the United States to promote the French higher education system to students and education stakeholders in the United States. Our organization provides information to institutions and students (American citizens and non-citizens studying and/or living in the United States) who wish to pursue academic projects at an institution of higher education in France for a period longer than three months. Students can either participate in a study abroad program for a semester or an academic year, or earn a full degree at a French university.

Students who plan to pursue an academic program in France for over 3 months must complete the Campus France application and obtain student visas before their departure.

Campus France USA is here to help students throughout their application process to a program in France. Our team will process applications before students apply for a visa.





THREE SCENARIOS

Study abroad students: Students must be enrolled in an American university and already accepted to a exchange program in France. Campus France requires a copy of the student's acceptance letter from the American or the French institution.

Independent students: Students must be already accepted to an independent program in France. This program must include at least 15 hours of class per week. Campus France requires a copy of the student's acceptance from the French program.

University applicants: Students wishing to apply to a full undergraduate or graduate degree program at a French higher education institution must follow the `DAP/Hors-DAP` user guide.

CAMPUS FRANCE APPLICATION

To complete the Campus France application, students must:

Step 1: Register for a PASTEL account online at usa.campusfrance.org

Step 2: Fill out their Campus France Form in the PASTEL system

Step 3: Send us a copy of their acceptance letter (from the partnering French or American institution) and a money order for \$100, made out to `MCUFEU`. Make sure to mention the student`s Campus France ID #(USXXXXXXX) on the enveloped and on the money order.

Step 4: Each student will receive a PASTEL confirmation message within three weeks.

Step 5: Schedule an appointment at the nearest consulate to get a visa.
