



THE HSS CHATEAUBRIAND FELLOWSHIP

is a fellowship program offered by the Cultural Services of the French Embassy in the US. It targets outstanding Ph.D. students from American universities who seek to engage in research in France, in any discipline of the Humanities and Social Sciences. Chateaubriand fellows are selected through a merit-based competition, through a binational collaborative process involving expert evaluators from both countries.

The HSS Chateaubriand fellowship program's purpose is to foster bilateral cooperation at Ph.D. and research level, and to build and strengthen bridges between French and American research institutions.

We offer three types of fellowships :

- Fall Fellowship : 4 months, starts October 1st
- Spring Fellowship : 4 months, starts February 1st
- Year-long Fellowship : 8 months, starts October 1st

Applicants' preference will be taken into account but not necessarily accommodated.

Benefits :

HSS Chateaubriand fellows receive :

- A monthly stipend of 1,500 €
- Health insurance for the entire duration of the fellowship
- A round-trip ticket to France with welcome package

ELIGIBILITY

Citizenship: Candidates do not have to be U.S. citizens, but they must be enrolled in an American university. However, French citizens are not eligible to apply.

Current activity: Candidates must be currently working on their Ph.D.

Letters of recommendation: Candidates must obtain a letter of recommendation from their advisor(s) in the U.S., as well as a letter of invitation from a professor affiliated with a French university or research institution.

SELECTION

Evaluations: Each application receives two evaluations : one from a French scholar, the other from an American scholar. The candidates' applications and their scholar's recommendations are then reviewed by a final selection committee.

CRITERIA:

- Academic relevance of the research project
- Beneficial effects of a research trip to France
- Student's command of the subject
- Contribution of the project to the global France / US Academic Exchange Context
