- Required before starting Internship II in undergraduate and MAT Traditional programs.
 - August 1 deadline for all Internship II requirements being completed for fall placement. To ensure scores are received by the deadline, candidates should take the test no later than June 30.
 - O December 1 deadline for all Internship II requirements being completed for spring placement. To ensure scores are received by the deadline, candidates should take the test no later than October 31.
- Required for admission to MAT Accelerated program.
 - February 15 deadline for Graduate School Application. To ensure scores are received by the deadline, candidates should take the test no later than January 15.
