## Instructions

- Apply and be accepted to Winthrop University. Priority deadline for admission is March 15.
- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
- Submit completed Call Me MISTER program application.
  - ◆ Two letters of recommendation
    - One from an educator or administrator representing the last school attended
    - One from a person of the student's choice who can describe the student's involvement in the community and/or potential for entering the teaching profession
  - Two essays
    - An essay entitled "Why I Want to Teach," which addresses the student's motivation for entering the teaching profession and the contributions he hopes to make to the profession and to the community as a teacher.
    - An essay entitled "How the Call Me MISTER Program Will Benefit Me as a Student"
  - A signed statement from a counselor or school official certifying that the student is from an under-served, under-privileged or economically disadvantaged background or area.
