Positive reinforcement is a means of identifying and teaching a specific behavior to students with the intention of seeing an increase in the desired behavior.





Task analysis is the process of breaking a skill down into smaller, more manageable components. Once a **task analysis** is complete, it can be used to teach students a skill that is too challenging to teach all at once.



Explicit instruction involves teaching a specific concept or procedure in a highly structured and carefully sequenced manner.

Model I do it.

Prompt We do it. Let's do this

together.

My turn.

Check You do it. Your turn.

Self-management involves the self- monitoring one's own behavior and independently completing tasks. For example, a checklist can help students develop their self-management skills.



Visual support is a communicational tool to enhance communication by using visual aids such as pictures, drawings, videos, charts etc.
