
WARMTH & CONTROL:

WE USED TO THINK...

- WE USED TO THINK TEACHERS WERE EITHER WARM **OR** CONTROLLING.
- TODAY: CAREFUL ANALYSES OF EFFECTIVE TEACHING REVEAL THAT THE **BEST** TEACHERS HAVE HIGH DEGREES OF BOTH **WARMTH** AND **CONTROL**.
