Internship I – fall 2024

August 1 (Aug 5- Lancaster) – Interns will begin at their host schools (the day their mentor teacher begins for the year).

Monday, August 5 – Required Initial Internship Institute for all Internship I teacher candidates. The session will be held in the Student Activity Center then Plowden Auditorium and will run from 4:00-6:00. Feel free to join the session.

Thursday, August 8 - NEW Supervisor training on WU forms and processes - 9:00-11:00 - New supervisors will be notified of the location prior to the meeting.

Monday, August 12 or Wednesday, August 14 - Supervisor meeting for ALL supervisors – 9:00-10:00 – Supervisors choose 1 virtual meeting to attend. Meeting location TBA

Tuesday, August 13 - Mentor Informational Meeting – Option 1 - 4:30-5:30 – virtual through zoom – link for joining the meeting will be sent in advance -**One of two dates offered for this informational meeting* (Supervisors are welcome to attend. – New supervisors are encouraged to attend one of the sessions.)

Digital signatures that are accepted as long as it is a capture of your hand-written signature. <u>Please note</u>, that if conducting introductory meetings face-to-face with the interns you supervise and their mentors, **your authorization needs to be in place at least 7 days before** that meeting. Introductory meetings, whether face-to-face or virtual, need to take place within the first two weeks of school.)
