## Students can apply for admission once they have:

- 1. Viewed the videos on admission to the Teacher Education Program
- 2. Completed a minimum of 45 semester hours, 15 of which must be completed at Winthrop
- 3. Maintained a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 for coursework completed at Winthrop
- 4. Completed the following core courses with a grade of "C" or better in each course: EDCO 101, EDCO 200, and EDCO 201 or EDCO 202 or equivalents.
- 5. Achieved satisfactory field evaluations in EDCO 200, and EDCO 201 or EDCO 202 or equivalents.
- 6. Passed all three sections of either the PRAXIS Core Academic Skills for Educators Test or PRAXIS I or have satisfied the testing requirements with minimum scores on the SAT, SAT I or ACT.
