ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students can apply for admission once they have:

1. Viewed the videos on admission to the Teacher Education Program
2. Completed a minimum of 45 semester hours, 15 of which must be completed at Winthrop
3. Maintained a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 for coursework completed at Winthrop
4. Completed the following core courses with a grade of “C” or better in each course: EDCO 101, EDCO 200, and EDCO 201 or EDCO 202 or equivalents.
5. Achieved satisfactory field evaluations in EDCO 200, and EDCO 201 or EDCO 202 or equivalents.
6. Passed all three sections of either the PRAXIS Core Academic Skills for Educators Test or PRAXIS I or have satisfied the testing requirements with minimum scores on the SAT, SAT I or ACT.

When **ALL** the above requirements are met, students are eligible to apply. Students wishing to apply for admission to Teacher Education may do so (online only) by visiting:

- a disclosure statement concerning criminal/unethical conduct including any judicial or disciplinary action taken while enrolled at Winthrop University or another institution of higher education,
