It is the opinion of the Council of Student Leaders that 25 26 such a grading policy should not be in effect at Winthrop University for these reasons; however 27 28 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we strongly support 31 amending the S/U option to include a mechanism that will 32 allow professors to assign a grade of an A if a student has 33 performed to such a standard in a class that a student 34 elected to use the S/U option at the beginning of the 35 semester. Such a change would allow for more flexibility and give students more options.
