24 25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, South Carolina ranks last in the Southeast region in terms of state and local funding for full time equivalent students at two-year institutions; and
29 30 31 32	WHEREAS, the lottery grant program provides an appreciated service to South Carolina students and families; and
33 34 35 36	WHEREAS, financial aid is distinct and can not replace student appropriations to South Carolina Institutions of Higher Education; and
37 38 39	WHEREAS, students' priorities for higher education include accessibility and quality; and
40 41 42 43 44	WHEREAS, by mandating a tuition cap without providing base funding to meet institutional responsibilities will decrease the quality of higher education in South Carolina; NOW THEREFORE

48 49 50	${\bf THAT}$ the Council of Student Leaders opposes the tuition cap proposal; and
