${ }^{3}$ MUSA 14_, 15_ or 16_: Small Ensemble Requirement - composition students must complete at least two semesters of small ensemble as a performer. Composition majors may elect to participate as a performer or conductor in any 141 - 149 ensemble involved in reading/performing new music or student compositions.
${ }^{5}$ MUST Electives above 299: Any MUST courses above 299.

## MINIMUM GRADE REQUIREMENT

Music majors must receive a minimum grade of C in every music course (MUSA or MUST) used to meet requirements for a music degree.
