














Block. Fiber.* Watch artists live create prints of life-sized woodblocks on paper and fabric, and catch a glimpse into our busy printmaking studio at Winthrop!

"Hand. Block. Fiber. is the collaborative effort of ten Relief Printmaking students from Winthrop University. Throughout the semester, the focus has been on individually developed concepts and the evolution from technical assignments into a cohesive body of work. Through portraiture, life-sized figures, and repeat patterns, hand-carved woodblocks have been printed on a variety of specific papers and fabrics to further independent thought and interests. We invite conversation, debate, and a space to reflect upon the research presented."






