




HAND. BLOCK. FIBER.

ST-ARTS Program June 6 - June 24, 2022

Since the ST-ARTS program's inception in 1989, Winthrop has hosted more than 9,000 students for the annual ST-ARTS (Students with Special Talents in the Arts) program. This program

connects middle school-aged students with more than 50 talented artists and musicians and allows them to intensively study a specific arts area. Arts areas include music, dance, design, drama and photography.

Nearly 300 students attend three weeks of music, dance, drama, design and photography classes on Winthrop's campus each summer. Most importantly, scholarships are available with participating districts to students to cover tuition.



Michael began his career at Winthrop University in 1979 as an adjunct percussion instructor. In 1986 he became a full-time

faculty member, and during his 31-year tenure he helped build the percussion studies program and received the Kinard Award for Excellence in Teaching. An internationally-recognized author, composer, and performer specializing in mbira and djembe, Michael found his greatest professional satisfaction in working with students to help them reach their musical and personal potential. He retired as a professor emeritus of music in 2017 and was recognized by the Percussive Arts Society with its Outstanding Service Award that year.


