

Claudia O'Steen joined Winthrop in 2018 after teaching in the Department of Art at the University of West Florida. Her efforts have been impressive to date, including her dedication to new course and program development, refinement of existing curriculum, the creation of course content, undergraduate research activities, the

creation of an equitable learning environment and dedication to extracurricular activities.

As a digital media specialist and interdisciplinary artist, O'Steen has spent considerable time developing courses that emphasize both. She has worked with a colleague to create a new concentration in expanded media that will meet market and student demands. She also has worked extensively across departments, particularly with dance and music, on projects that blend the strengths of different artistic expressions.

All of her initiatives have led to the contemporising of the Department of Fine Arts and made pathways for students and faculty to collaborate across the College of Visual and Performing Arts' disciplines.
