Audition Assignment

For this assignment, you will need to fulfill the responsibilities pertaining to conducting auditions, e.g. turning in your audition sign-up sheet, attending all choreographers' auditions, facilitating your audition in a manner that aligns with your proposed creative intentions, ability to see the variety of skills needed to perform your piece, and clearly communicates what you want to see the dancers perform. You will turn in the following information in class prior to the audition: 1) a brief description of your work including the theme, creative inspiration, and style of movement; 2) your desired number of dancers; 3) the skills dancers need to possess in order to perform your piece; and 4) how you plan to facilitate the audition. Please include the information listed above in the order in which it appears in this handout. The rubric below will be used to evaluate your audition.
