Below is the rubric to guide you for your presentations. The time frame is 10-15 minutes. This means you must plan for the information you wish to present. Be aware that visuals (such as PowerPoint, video clips) should only enhance your presentation not dominate. Ask yourself, "What do you want the audience to know about how the timeline was developed and choices regarding information included. What do you want the audience to take away from your presentation?"
