- 2. To what extent does the essay use evidence from the scripts to support ideas?
- 3. To what extent does the essay use outside sources to support ideas?
- 4. What kind of citation/documentation of outside sources does this essay include?
- 5. To what extent has the student avoid mechanical writing problems?
- 6. To what extent does the student demonstrate her/his knowledge of concepts from our texts and class presentations.
- 7. To what extent does the student demonstrate critical and analytical skills in the essay.
- 8. How well does the student incorporate Hsu's essay into the content of the essay?
