Department of Theatre and Dance Criteria for Producers Circle Scholarships

In determining recipients of Producers Circle Scholarships, the faculty considers the student's application and essay, past accomplishments and contributions to the department, potential for development and future contributions, professional integrity and maturity, and financial need including the applicant's other financial aid awards and residency (in-state/out-of-state).

Eligibility Requirements

The scholarship recipient must be a full-time theatre or dance major at Winthrop University and have at least a 3.0 GPA at the time of the application.

The applicant must:

- have demonstrated consistent commitment and significant contribution to the Theatre and Dance Department.
- have been a theatre or dance major in the Department of Theatre and Dance for one semester prior to the awarding of the scholarship.
- be a student in residence at Winthrop for the semester(s) that he/she has the award. (The faculty may award a partial scholarship to a student who might be planning to spend one semester studying abroad or on exchange.)

To apply for this scholarship, the student must:

1. Complete a scholarship application form, providing **ALL** information requested on the form and must obtain a faculty member's signature as a recommendation in support of the scholarship application. **Be aware that faculty members will want to read the application and essay before signing. Please present your application to a faculty member several days before the deadline, so that she/he will have time to review it.** Forms are available in the Department of Theatre and Dance Office or on the department website.
2. Attach a résumé to the application which provides detailed information about participation in the department, including courses, performance, production work and service.
3. Attach a 200 - 500-word essay to the application that clearly addresses the following prompts:
 - **How do you see your potential and involvement continuing and expanding in your future semester(s) here in the department?**
 - **Describe your attitude, attendance and professional behavior in class and in rehearsal. How can it improve?**
 - **What are your financial needs that this scholarship will address? Discuss other scholarships you will or may be receiving.**
