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Director's Note:

I was first introduced to "Pippin" as a dancer in the show, and I am thrilled to revisit this piece now as a director. Working with this wonderful group of students at Winthrop has been a delightful introduction to my time here. I want to share my deepest gratitude to the two women whose collaboration, intelligence, and creativity have infused this process with joy and laughter, choreographer Kelly Ozust and music director Dr. Ashley West-Davis. What you will see today is a collaboration of technical, design, and creative work.

When approaching this piece as a director, I found myself drawn to the real danger Pippin is faced with on his unceasing quest to find fulfillment. Is anything fulfilling if you sacrifice everything to achieve it? Despite having opened on Broadway in 1972, its depictions of abuse of power, war, media, human relationship, and missing what is right in front of you remain relevant today. This story is an examination of the human experience and the never-ending question: what is it that brings us purpose, fulfillment, and peace? While Pippin questions the cost and extent we will go to find our "corner of the sky," it is up to the individual to decide where the answer lies. Does the true meaning of life rest in the extraordinary or the "extra ordinary?" While the journey to answer these questions remains unique to the individual, the story of Pippin can help remind us all that sometimes what matters most is closer than we may initially think.

Enjoy the show, escape your world for a moment, and in the end, I hope you are reminded of where your corner of the sky is.
