Committee Reports



Rules Committee report by Arran Hamm (Vote needed)

Pat Ballard [retired] from Winthrop effective July 1. She has one year remaining in her term on the Faculty Personnel Committee. With her retirement, Dacus has only 1 tenured faculty member eligible to finish her term, or to serve a subsequent term. Per the Faculty Conference Bylaws (Article VII, Section 1, paragraph 2), the Dacus Library Faculty Assembly herewith requests the following exception to the Faculty Personnel Committee membership requirements:



 The membership requirements for the Faculty personnel Committee state that department chairs are ineligible to serve. We request an exception to allow a tenured library department chair to serve on the committee. We request this exception for a duration of 4 years (the final year of Pat Ballard's term, and 3 years to allow for the possibility of re-election). While serving on the committee, the library faculty member must recuse herself from deliberation if action regarding a library faculty member comes before the committee.
