SACSCOC

- Institutional accrediting body (Southern Association of College and Schools Commission on Colleges)
- Accredits over 800 colleges and universities (technical colleges/community colleges through Research 1 universities)
- Accredits 11 states within the southeast region
- Link between the Department of Education (federal government) and institutions of higher education -> accreditation allows an institution access to **federal money**, which is awarded to students as financial aid

Winthrop Submissions

Collectively, submitted 670 pages of narrative and over 2,500 documents. Committee knows quite a bit about Winthrop University.

- Focused Report and QEP (Quality Enhancement Plan)
 - Submitted January 2022
 - Response to the Off-Site Committee concerns
 - First submission of QEP



Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP)

A QEP is a five-year project to *enhance* an aspect of student learning and/or student success. SACSCOC requires a QEP proposal as part of the decennial. Winthrop's first QEP focused on global learning; this one will focus on career readiness.

Topic Selected, Developed, and Proposal Submitted

- QEP Topic Selection Committee (surveys, document reviews)
- QEP Topic Development Committee (research, best practices)
- Now/Next (in addition to the on-site visit by SACSCOC):
 - QEP, named "Flight Ready," Implementation Team now meeting, piloting components
 - UCM partnering to promote (logomark, promotions campaign)
 - Website to be established (full proposal will be available)
 - QEP Director to be recruited (half-time position)
 - Full launch of "Flight Ready" begins August 2022 (Year One)
