# Academic Misconduct Process NEW STEPS

Step 1 – Notify the student of your concern & Report Academic Misconduct

- Example of Notification Email Available on Sharepoint
- Faculty Member will provide recommended class sanctioning in report.
- \*Your part is done!\*

# Class Sanctioning

As you consider the appropriate consequence for the violation, some things to consider:

- Intentionality of academic misconduct Was it a blatant violation?
- Does the student seem confused about the accusation? Did they not understand some aspect of citations or instructions?
- Would an educational approach work? (Redoing the assignment for a reduced grade)
- For a first time violation, avoid a heavy handed approach that would result in failure of course

## **Academic Misconduct Process**

Steps Continued...



Step 2 – Student will receive notification of charges from DOSO Step 3 – Student will meet with DOSO to determine how they want to handle the violation.

### **Academic Misconduct Process**

Steps Continued...

Step 4 – Administrative Hearing or Conduct Board Hearing

Step 5 – Outcome is emailed to student along with determined sanctions (Faculty will be copied)



# Strategies for Evaluating Academic Misconduct

- Turnitin / ChatGPTZero
  - These systems are not fool proof, be sure to review the report and critically evaluate flags.
- Evaluate Other Writing/Work Submitted
- Look for Differences in Tone/Quality from Other Work Submitted
- Have Students Complete at least ONE in class writing assignment for a writing sample
- Make your expectations CLEAR Syllabus & Communication
