## WINTHROP MCNAIR SCHOLARS PROGRAM

Winthrop's Ronald E. McNair PostBaccalaureate Achievement Program helps outstanding **first generation college students from low-income families and students from groups underrepresented in graduate education conduct high quality research and find, fund, and prepare to succeed in doctoral programs.** We are funded to serve 30 students each year through 2028. A competitive and renewable U.S. Department of Education TRiO grant provides \$272,364 in federal funding, representing 74% of program costs. Winthrop contributes the remaining 26% of costs with approximately \$94,930 in cash and in-kind funds. Undergraduates at Winthrop and 22 other S.C. institutions who have at least 30 earned hours, at least one year left to graduate, and a 3.0 GPA are encouraged to apply before November 1. All majors welcome!

## **Program Outcomes**

**96-100%** of participants **complete high quality research** every year

97% of participants persist to earn a Bachelor's Degree

84% of our graduates enrolled in grad school (e.g., Stanford, NYU, Illinois, Johns Hopkins, Oregon, UGA, San Diego SU, Michigan, Utah, Temple, U Penn, Vanderbilt, Winthrop, & many more)

75% of all grads earned at least one grad degree and/or are enrolled this year

2 - 7 alumni doctorates each year (e.g Alabama, Colorado, Duke, Emory, Florida, FIT, Georgia Tech, Indiana, NCSU, Maryland, UNC, Notre Dame, Northeastern, Rochester, USC, UT, Wake Forest, WVU, & more)

## Transformational Experiences

Scholars are recruited and selected for **prestigious national research**, **graduate study, and funding opportunities** because of their McNair preparation (e.g, MIT, UC Berkeley, & Harvard summer internships)

Our summer research internship includes: \$2800 stipend, on-campus housing and meals, a free course, conference travel, and faculty mentoring

Scholars have funding for travel to present research and visit graduate programs, apply to grad programs, grad test prep and fees, & more
