Winthrop University Pool Regulations for Weather Conditions

The Winthrop University pool may close from time to time, based on possible unsafe weather conditions or situations, or when weather conditions are so poor that the likelihood of resident swimmers is very small. The closure of the Winthrop University pool is at the discretion of the lifeguard on duty or the Assistant Director for Fitness and Aquatics.

The Winthrop University pool may close (but is not limited to) due to the following reasons:

The pool will be evacuated in the event of either thunder or lightning, as is recommended by the American Red Cross and National Weather Service. The pool will remain empty for 30 minutes after the last occurrence of thunder and/or lightning. The pool may close for the remainder of the day if the thunder or lightning continues for one hour or more.
