- IV. Report from the Provost and Vice President of Academic Affairs Sebastian van Delden The provost did not present any news but noted appreciation of the GFA's work.
- V. Report from the Graduate Council

Dustin Hoffman. Graduate Council Chair

- Policy modifications requiring a vote
  - o None at this time.
- Curriculum Action requiring vote by GFA
  - New Program: Doctorate of Education in Learning, Leading, and Organizational Change
    - *The program is 51 hours and will be online.*
    - It is to be decided how many and what kinds of faculty/administrators will need to be hired to support the program and where the funds will come from.
    - The cumulative final project will be a dissertation.
    - There is a motion to amend the program to rename to Doctorate of Leadership and Innovation.
    - Candidates would be expected to create an innovation change within an organization and/or the community in which they are exchanged through a multi-disciplinary approach. Including "innovation" in the title reflects the "innovation change" curriculum in the courses. This ED is not limited to K-12 and higher-ed focuses.
    - Other similar ED programs at other universities do not have "learning" in the title. No other programs in the world have the originally proposed name, and the originally proposed name is hard to remember even for stakeholders of the program. CHE is encouraging institutions like ours to add professional doctoral programs.
    - This program has been proposed by an interdisciplinary team.
    - Name change was unanimously approved.
    - The program was unanimously approved.
    - This program is now moving to the Board of Trustees for approval.

- New Program: Master of Music in Music with a Concentration in Conducting

- New Program: Master of Music in Music with a Concentration Performance
  - This is merging three separate programs together into a program with three different concentrations.
  - These three programs were unanimously approved.

  - The credit hour modifications of these programs were unanimously approved.
