

# Add LibGuide Resources to a Course Using the Automagic Tool

## Overview

This tutorial will show you how to add the automagic version of **LibGuides Resources to a Course**. The automagic version will display library resources relating to the course's subject that have been setup by a Dacus Library Librarian.



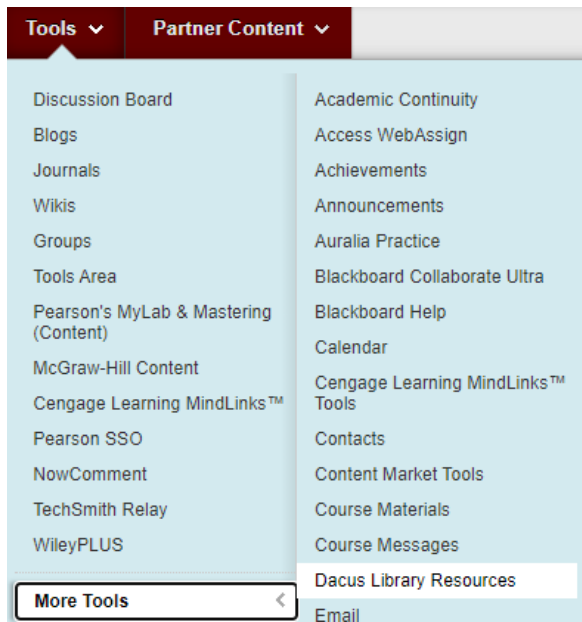
*If a parent course has been created, you will want to add the LibGuides resources via the manual option.*

## Quick Steps

Content Area > Tools > Dacus Library Resources > Available to Users > Submit > View LibGuides

## Step 1

In your Blackboard course, navigate to a Content Area, hover over *Tools* on the Action Bar, and select "Dacus Library Resources" [1].





If Dacus Library Resources does not appear in the list, click More Tools then select Dacus Library Resources.

## Step 2

It is recommended to leave the “Link Name” as the default of “Dacus Library Resources” [2].

Click the *Submit* button to save and insert the Tool in the Content Area.
