

Expectations for Student Produced Audio and Video

Overview

Winthrop University takes its mission to provide equal access of opportunity seriously. For this reason, students who produce audio and/or video content for their courses must create that content with Accessibility practices in mind.

The following is a list of expectations you should consider before distributing any audio or video content through Blackboard Learn.

Expectations

- Students will submit a transcript with their audio/video files if the activity requires peer review of the videos. If the assignment is being submitted to the instructor only, a transcript is not required.
- If the audio/video will be peer reviewed, the students will write a script before recording their audio/video.
- The script will include descriptions of any visual elements instead of using “as shown in the chart/graph” language.
- The script will include section headings to make it clear where transitions are being made.
- The students will upload their script with their audio/video file to Blackboard.
