


APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Winthrop Office of Online Learning Updates

Spring 2022



1. TechSmith Knowmia Transition

- TechSmith is phasing out the video hosting portion of its business.
- Our video hosting platform, TechSmith Knowmia, will be retired on August 31, 2022.
- TechSmith will continue to maintain a high level of service reliability, customer support, incident response time, and we will receive security patches and critical bug fixes through August 31, 2022.
- You may continue to use TechSmith in the spring and summer. The two systems will run parallel in the spring and summer and we will transition everyone by the end of the summer.




1. TechSmith Knowmia Transition

- An RFP was conducted between October 2021 and January 2022 for a new platform. Panopto was awarded the contract, which will begin in March 2022. Panopto training sessions will be offered through the Center for Professional Excellence. Panopto contains a wider range of features than TechSmith Knowmia, so we are excited about adding value to your instructional videos.
- TechSmith will migrate all of the video content on its server to Panopto, including captions and interactive elements, such as quizzes.
- Faculty and Staff will not have to migrate their own videos, but will need to relink the videos in their courses or organizations once they are in Panopto.
- Two-phase Migration Plan: March June, June August.

3. Blackboard Moving to Multifactor Authentication (MFA)

 Testing has begun to move Blackboard to the Winthrop Single Sign On (including Multi-Factor Authentication) that is already in use with Zoom, Wingspan, and Office 365, which will add security to your user account as well as allow Winthrop to be compliant with various state and federal regulations. We are working to implement Single Sign On for Blackboard in a manner that will allow for the best possible user experience. We will follow up with more details prior to implementation.



4. Preferred First Name and Personal Pronouns for Faculty, Staff and Students in Blackboard

- The preferred first name is currently passed to Blackboard from Banner and displays in Blackboard Original and Ultra courses.
- As of 11/15/2021, personal pronouns will display in Ultra courses in the following areas:
 - Assessments
 - Course Roster
 - Communication Tools (Discussions and Messages)
 - Gradebook
 - Groups
 - User profile
- Personal pronouns will display in Blackboard Original experience courses in late Spring 2022.



5. Sign up to Join the Ultra Squad!

- Our first group of faculty, staff and students were trained in and used the new Blackboard Ultra Course Experience this fall. We are grateful to these pioneers and we are now inviting the next group of interested faculty and staff to participate for Summer or Fall 2022.
- We welcome faculty and staff teaching in all modalities, including those who use Blackboard to supplement face-to-face courses and those who use Blackboard Organizations.
- If you are interested, please first obtain approval from your department before seeking to use Ultra within your program.


