Open Educational Resources (OERs) & Winthrop

- From 2020-21 the Consumer Price Index rose 65.5%.

 Textbooks rose 150%!
- Studies indicate
 - Over 60% of students don't purchase the text
 - The cost of books impacts their class selection
 - The cost of books impacts their field of study
 - The cost of books disproportionally affects Pelleligible and first-generation students

OERs are teaching, learning and research materials that have a license that permits no-cost access, use, and adaptation by others.

Students have access to the textbook on the first day of class.

- ✓ SUCCESS students are more likely to succeed when they have the text.
- ✓ EQUITABLE ALL students have access to the text from day one.
- ✓ MENTAL HEALTH Access to the text reduces the stress of trying to "make do" without purchasing it.




