The most recent Winthrop Poll was released last Thursday, April 28. The poll interviewed residents of South Carolina about issues of race in the Palmetto State and the country as a whole. Here is a glimpse of the findings listed on the Winthrop Poll page: "When asked to rate the state of race relations in the United States, 41% of S.C. African Americans said it is poor. In comparison, 69% of whites rated race relations as either good or only fair. There was more hope about the Palmetto State where 32% of African American residents rated the state's race relations as poor, while 76% of whites rated it as either good or only fair." ### Staff Assembly Voting Guidelines

The Staff Assembly has representatives from Academic Affairs, Access and Enrollment Management, Athletics, Finance and Business, Human Resources – Employee Diversity and Wellness, Institutional Advancement, Office of the President, Student Life, and University Relations. Each member serves a two year term with a maximum of two terms. There are seven openings for representatives in the upcoming election, and their term will begin on July 1, 2016.

Please be on the lookout for nomination and voting emails.

#### The Process

- 1. Announcements of openings are e-mailed to each division.
- 2. Nominations are open for five work days.
- 3. Nominees are asked if willing to serve.
- 4. HR verifies the nominee has worked here for at least one year.
- 5. Voting is open for 10 work days.
- 6. The results are announced no more than two work days after elections.
