
# Estimated Student Loan Debt Upon Graduation

The maximum Federal Direct Loan amounts for an academic year are

- \$5,500 for first-year undergraduates
- \$6,500 for second-year undergraduates
- \$7,500 for third- and fourth-year undergraduates

Borrowing the maximum each academic year would result in a total of \$27,000
