The individual named above was supported through the *Winthrop Initiative for STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) Educators (WISE)* while completing certification coursework. The *WISE* program was funded by a National Science Foundation Grant through the Robert Noyce Scholarship Program. *WISE* participation required that the scholar named above agree to complete years of service teaching in a high-need school or a district that contains a high-need school.

This form must be completed annually in the spring as confirmation that service was indeed completed. In cases where the school meets the qualifications for designation as a high-need setting, the signature of a building-level administrator is sufficient. In cases where teaching occurred in a district in which a high-need school is located, but the school in which service was performed is not itself designated as high-need, a *district*-level administrator must *also* sign the form. Note that service as a long term substitute teacher qualifies for this requirement if the time spent in classrooms meets the time expectation for a full year of service (as defined below). In such cases, the signature of a district-level administrator is also required. There are different statements to sign below for each scenario; please complete the section that best meets the criteria for the person named above.

The following provides a list of definitions to consider when confirming service:

- A high-need school is defined as a school that meets at least one of the following criteria:
  - 1) A school in which at least 50% of the enrolled students are living in poverty. This can be determined by eligibility for participation in programs such as the free and reduced price lunch program established by the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C.1751 et seq.) or Medicaid assistance.
  - 2) A school in which: (i) more than 34% of the academic classroom teachers at the secondary level (across all academic subjects, not just mathematics and science) do not have an undergraduate degree with a major or minor in, or a graduate degree in, the academic field in which they teach the largest percentage of their classes; or (ii) more than 34% of the teachers in any two of the academic departments do not have an undergraduate degree with a major or minor in, or a graduate degree in, the academic field in which they teach the largest percentage of their classes.
  - 3) A school in which the teacher attrition rate has been 15% or more over the last three school years.
- One *year of service* is defined as at least 152 days of teaching (the number of days required in South Carolina for one year of teaching credit) in a STEM classroom.
